ORDINANCE NO. 2021- <u>10</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, TO BE KNOWN AS ANABELLE ISLAND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 190, FLORIDA STATUTES; NAMING THE DISTRICT; DESCRIBING THE EXTERNAL BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT; DESCRIBING THE FUNCTIONS AND POWERS OF THE DISTRICT; DESIGNATING FIVE PERSONS TO SERVE AS THE INITIAL MEMBERS OF THE DISTRICT'S BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Recitals

WHEREAS, KB Home Jacksonville LLC (the "Petitioner"), having obtained written consent to the establishment of the Anabelle Island Community Development District (the "District") by the owners of one-hundred percent (100%) of the real property to be included in the District, petitioned the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") of Clay County, Florida (the "County"), to adopt an ordinance establishing the District pursuant to Chapter 190, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioner is a foreign limited liability company with an address of 7948 Merchants Way, Jacksonville, Florida 32222; and

WHEREAS, all interested persons and affected units of general-purpose local government were afforded an opportunity to present oral and written comments on the petition at a duly noticed public hearing conducted by the Board on March 23, 2021; and

WHEREAS, upon consideration of the record established at that hearing, the Board determined that the statements within the Petition are true and correct, that the establishment of the District is not inconsistent with any applicable element or portion of the state comprehensive plan or the County's comprehensive plan, that the land within the District is of sufficient size, is sufficiently compact, and is sufficiently contiguous to be developable as a functionally interrelated community, that the District is the best alternative available for delivering community development services and facilities to the area that will be served by the District, that the capacity and uses of existing local and regional community development services and facilities, and that the area that will be served by the District is amenable to separate special-district governance; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of the District shall not act to amend any land development approvals governing the land area to be included within the District; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of the District will constitute a timely, efficient, effective, responsive and economic way to deliver community development services in the area described in the petition; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the initial members of the District's Board of Supervisors set forth in Section 5 of this ordinance are residents of the State of Florida and citizens of the United States of America.

Be It Ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Clay County:

Section 1. <u>Authority</u>. This Ordinance is adopted in compliance with and pursuant to the Uniform Community Development District Act of 1980 codified in Chapter 190, Florida Statutes. Nothing contained herein shall constitute an amendment to any land development approvals for the land area included within the District.

Section 2. <u>District Name</u>. There is hereby created a community development district situated entirely within a portion of the unincorporated area of Clay County, Florida, which shall be known as the "Anabelle Island Community Development District", and which shall be referred to in this ordinance as the "District".

Section 3. <u>District External Boundaries</u>. The external boundaries of the District are described in Appendix A attached hereto, said boundaries encompassing 164.13 acres, more or less.

Section 4. <u>District Powers and Functions</u>. The powers and functions of the District are described in Chapter 190, Florida Statutes. Consent is hereby given to the District's Board of Supervisors to finance, fund, plan, establish, acquire, construct, reconstruct, enlarge or extend, equip, operate, and maintain systems and facilities for parks and facilities for indoor and outdoor recreational, cultural, and educational uses, and for security, all as authorized and described by Sections 190.012(2)(a) and (2)(d), Florida Statutes (2020).

Section 5. <u>Board of Supervisors</u>. The five persons designated to serve as initial members of the District's Board of Supervisors are as follows:

Section 6. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof, is finally determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, such provision shall be deemed to be severable and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect provided that the invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision is not material to the logical and intended interpretation of this ordinance.

Section 7. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall become effective as prescribed by Florida general law.
